Howlings Foundation for Clean Water, Danamark is committed to making clean and safe water available to all Canadians by 2020. “Our goal over the next few years is to take Project Water National” says Robin Howlings, president of Danamark WaterCare. “We need to reduce the number of disposable water bottles being distributed and replace them with water filtration equipment and sustainable reusable bottles”.

Danamark WaterCare has continued with its commitment to Project Water for four years now, in helping them distribute bottled water to more than 160 social service agencies in Toronto and across the GTA. Agencies that receive the water include the Salvation Army, the Canadian Red Cross, Street Health Bus, St. John Ambulance, the Scott Mission and the YWCA.
